Roofing System: Rubberised Plygene Gutterline System



The Problem

InBev Brewery at Salmesbury is one of three depots in the UK and its warehouse distributes the majority of the UK's stock of Stella Artois, Becks and Budweiser. A large number of leaks were being experienced from the metal valley gutters which were causing numerous issues within the warehouse including damaged stock and producing possible slip / trip hazards.

Weatherproofing Advisors Ltd were tasked with providing a solution which could be installed quickly and with minimal disruption to the operations of the Brewery.

The Solution

Weatherproofing Advisors Ltd specified HD Sharman's Rubberised Plygene Gutterline System. This made to measure 'gutter within a gutter' is simple, quick and cost effective.

The Benefits

The gutter was produced to the exact dimensions of each valley gutter and delivered in a one piece, joint free roll, with each valley gutter measuring 163m long. The one piece construction reduces the number of joints and on site welding which are possible future failure areas.

The simple installation meant that a total of almost 500m of gutter liner was completed by three operatives in less than two weeks.

The flexible immensely strong liner will easily tolerate extremes of temperature without adverse effect and is trafficable which aids annual gutter cleaning.

The system is subject to a 20 year guarantee and has been awarded BBA Approval.
